Payments may also be made in euros, with their amount determined based on the prevailing exchange rate against the US dollar (USD) on the date of the transaction.

In case of any difficulties, the authors should send the abstracts and author information to the E-mails of corresponding scientific commissions. At the end of this document we detailed the information to be included.

The scientific committee will receive the proposals and reserves the right to determine the modality of participation (virtual or in-person) and the form of presentation (oral, poster, others). Students must accredit their condition through a letter issued by their institution.

The In-person Delegate category (professional or student) grants the right to credential, accreditation module, general and scientific program, presentation of research results, participation certificate, access to scientific and social activities of the opening and closing of the event.

Abstract

The abstract must be monolithic (a single paragraph). Abstracts are accepted in Spanish, English or Portuguese written on A4 page size, with Times New Roman 12 font, single spaced, justified and not exceeding 400 words. It must contain the following information: objectives, methods used, main results and conclusions. The title should summarize the main result of the work and not exceed 15 words.

Keywords: Up to a maximum of five words or phrases. Each word must be written with an initial capital letter and be separated by semicolons.

Category: Oral presentation or Poster

Other information to be specified if sending by E-mail: e-mail, CI/Passport, Phone number, nationality, scientific/docent category.
